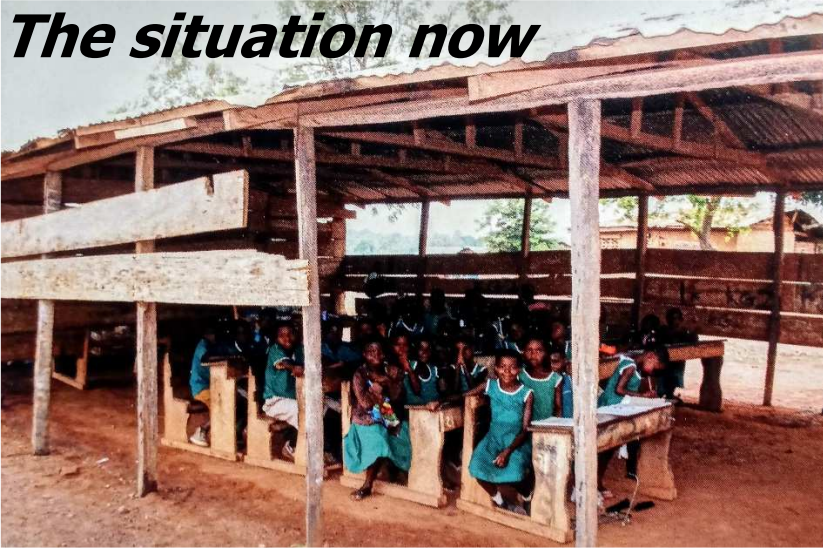

Location

Nsuta, Techiman, Ghana

Nsuta is one of a number of small villages in the vicinity, all of which will be served by the new facility.

The whole area is blighted by poverty.

Programme

Site-work started October 2020

Projected completion April 2022

The project is for an Education Centre, providing facilities for adult education as well as for children aged 6-16 years.

The whole purpose of this project is to provide access to the foundation of a more meaningful, purposeful and fulfilling life for all concerned in these rural communities.

The installation is designed to be sustainable. Rotary sees itself as being committed long-term to this project.

We will be asking the public to help us, not simply financially, but also with donations of English-language children's books, and teaching materials, second-hand laptops and any suitable stationery supplies.
